LOST HORN VINEYARD OKANAGAN FALLS OKANAGAN VALLEY

Okanagan Falls is one of the unique sites in BC. Over tens of thousands of years glaciers carved a great valley and left behind mounds of rocky soils. This gravel along with warm days and cool nights lead to balanced, mineral laden red wines. Medium bodied and refreshing this wine packs black raspberry, pencil lead, and violets, and is framed by bright acidity.

Varietal: 100% Cabernet Franc

Winemaking: Aged in French oak (20% new) for thirteen months.

Yield: 3.5 tonnes per acre

Growing Degree Days: 1,395 degree days

Soil: Mounds of glacially deposited rock over sand

Aspect: South West
